Our Mission: Be the "Saving Grace" of Planet Earth!



These are excerpts from Solomon's audio "Working lesson with Cosmic Command." There are twelve angelconnected groups on Earth and it is our mission to heal Planet Earth. As Solomon said,

"One person alone is helpful but a group together with one intent is power."

Solomon: When he (Jesus) said the time for learning is over, he was referring to the fact that you have plodded along, learning slowly, slowly. The time of that is over. Now you must go quickly. ... Participant: Barb just had a good idea. Do you want to repeat it, Barb?

Participant: Well, not to be disrespectful for my own healing nature and the power of God, but - what as a collective group — what is the exact prayer, the exact thought that we can hold?

Participant: If you can save us some time and give us a prayer that everyone can say the exact same thing all the time, it might be very helpful.

Solomon: First of all, you must have love. You've

got to have love because that is the extreme power. Hold the earth in a light of love. Hold its people in a light of love, especially its leaders. Hold them in a light of love. And envision the power of God coming down through that and spreading out to all concerned. That is the best way to do that...

Participant: Okay, like this morning, you were saying to be very specific.

Solomon: Yes, specific of what you want, but you don't have to be specific to who because it knows, more than you, to go where it needs to go. You might have one idea of who needs it and that person may merely be a puppet to the real ones who are thinking so, let it go where it knows to go.

Participant: I suspect that that's going to be very powerful for the entire group that we are all on the same page with the same words. So, thank you very much...

Participant: Cause sometimes we focus on just the United States and sometimes we focus on Europe so all we have to do then is substitute. Instead of holding the earth in the light of love, holding the United States in the light of love.

Solomon: Focus on the earth.

Solomon: ... I say to you, you have no idea how important little groups like you are. You, collectively, are the SAVING GRACE, because you are the ONLY foundation to which we can connect and allow this energy that we're sending to come in.

Please take the time to send love to Mother Earth as often as possible in the way Solomon has taught us. This is our mission.

SGF Membership Survey

At the Spring Town Hall meeting, it was suggested that members be surveyed to obtain their input about a number of issues that are important to Sacred Garden Fellowship. In following up on that, Brandon Jopko, Tim McCarthy and Kathryn Romani created a five-question survey that was emailed to all SGF members later in the Spring.

The questions were designed to determine members' level of participation in SGF communications, as well as what topics members are interested in learning more about.

Overall, 18 out of 35 members responded to the survey. That's over 50% - a good sign of engagement. The survey highlights are:

Twelve people said they would like to get reacquainted with the Gabriel 101 Course.

Regarding SGF communications, out of all the responses, 94% read our emails, 89% read the newsletter, 72% read the blog, and 44% read the website.

A total of 10 members want to explore forgiveness in greater depth; 11 want to master healing; 6 want to learn more about abundance; 14 want to understand telepathy and 11 want to delve into spiritual dimensions more thoroughly. Other topics for further investigation that members were interested in were: 1) connecting with the higher realms of consciousness; 2) navigating transitions in the emotional body; 3) going further with the teachings given to us so far; 4) living our elevated selves in the illusory time and space.; 5) meditation and listening to God; 6) healing planet Earth; 7) self-love; 8) addictions; 9) the here and now and what the future holds; 10) living the lessons; 11) the power of the cosmic consciousness and our responsibility to use it; 12) clearing soul memory; 13) lesson on The Seven Rays; 14) attunement; and 15) taking the next step in spiritual evolvement.

Practices that members would like to learn more about include: 1) how to run groups and/or retreats, 2) metaphysical connection, 3) mediumship - Don's experiences and what Penny guided him through and 4) how to take some lessons and make

the language less 'Christian' terminology to appeal to a wider, more diverse audience (without changing the words of original texts/audio).

Members also commented that the blog has been extremely helpful in providing reminders of the many teachings we've had for decades.

Thank you to all who participated in the survey. The results are very helpful to the Board.



Looking Upon the Face of Fear



Recently I recalled Gabriel's cloud meditation from the *Manifesting* book. It's the one where you're sitting in a cloud and another cloud is coming towards you with your 'fear' or 'enemy' in the middle of it. Well, the past few days, I've felt like I've been having this fear of mine in the background of my thoughts especially when I'm trying to sleep at night. During a particular moment of awareness, I could visualize clearly what this fear looked like. I felt I needed to take this opportunity and give voice to what I was feeling and face my fear head-on.

I went to my local dollar store and purchased some Bristol board sheets and tempura paint because I had this feeling to get my hands dirty – to let my inner child be involved in this process, too.

On the first sheet I started with, I painted the 'face' of fear that I was visualizing as if it was in the cloud from Gabriel's meditation. You can't really see details from the picture, but I used the color black to

resemble this fear. It was like a spikey glob with spikes spewing back and forth – for me, a real intense feeling of fear. It had a big mouth with sharp teeth, too. I looked at this painting and gave voice to this fear by using guttural sounds that gradually evolved. I ended up screaming, as I looked at this face, to give awareness and expression to it and to ultimately face what I was afraid of.

The process I followed next is from James Gordon's book, *The Transformation*, as it uses three pictures to show three states of being. The first sheet I painted resembled 'me and my biggest problem,' which was the fear I was experiencing. I made sure to use my hands – no paint-brush required in this activity!

The second sheet resembles 'how and where I would like to be.' What I created for my second painting was several trees and water at the bottom with hearts scattered around the whole painting. To me, this demonstrated loving Mother Earth and being in harmony with her. Tears came.

The third sheet is intended to show 'how I get from here now to where I want to be.' I felt a lot of love being needed, so I created a big heart by alternating the colors I had. Clearly, love is what I need to be in order to get to where I want to be, which is ultimately one with my Self. With love, the fear is destroyed, and I can know that I am taken care of. I am loved by God. I can trust Him/Her. Oh yeah, my little boy also wanted to add hand prints on the painting to show that he was also here. Much love to him!

The intention with this process was to give expression to what I was feeling and overcome the fearful emotions. The painting came naturally and easily from my feeling nature.

The big ah-ha I had was: if I bring love to myself there is an inherent 'trust' in that feeling of love — trust that everything will be okay and will work out as it should. As Gabriel said in the *Manifesting* book, "Our future is guaranteed." Amen.
